Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Landscaping Fact Sheet

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. The completed upgrade improves travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of the project, new landscaping is being established around the intersection, incorporating approximately 80 semi-mature trees and 900 shrubs.

The landscape design and plant selection complement the local biodiversity, assisted by careful selection of trees and shrubs suitable to the area.

All new landscaping areas have been irrigated to assist with establishing the new trees and shrubs and to maintain them into the future.
