

Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade

Site Investigation Works - Old Belair Road, James Road, Sheoak Road, Main Road and Russell Street

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is continuing to plan for improvements to the Mitcham Hills road corridor.

We have received valuable feedback from the local community over the past year. This has been provided to our engineering and design consultants for consideration as the preferred concept designs are developed. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback.

Site investigation works along sections of Old Belair Road, James Road, Sheoak Road, Main Road and Russell Street, will commence this week and are expected to be complete by the end of November, weather permitting. Works will include:

- Location of underground services.
- Geotechnical investigations, and
- Flora and fauna assessments along the road corridors.

Works will be undertaken Monday to Friday between the hours of 9am and 5pm. All roads will remain open during works, however temporary lane and speed restrictions may be required when workers are on site.

Temporary footpath and bicycle lane detours may also be required. If this is the case, directional signage will be in place to guide people who are walking and riding.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

While some noise can be expected during geotechnical investigations, effort will be made to mitigate the disruption.

Access to properties and businesses in the area will be maintained at all times during works. In the event that private property access is required, we will contact you directly.

These investigative works form part of the planning process for the Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade project for which:

- The Federal Government has committed \$20 million towards an upgrade of Old Belair Road, with a focus on improving safety and transport efficiency at its junction with James Road.
- In addition, the State Government has committed \$20 million in State funding for the Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade, which includes an upgrade at the Main Road and Russell Street junction.
