
Pedestrian Crossing Works, Islington Railway Station, Prospect

The Australian and South Australian governments are jointly funding the electrification and modernisation of the Gawler rail line which will deliver a faster, cleaner and more reliable service, delivering an electrified network through Adelaide from Gawler to Seaford.

As part of this project, the existing pedestrian crossing at the Islington Railway Station will be temporarily closed while works to complete an upgrade to the crossing are underway.

When: works will commence in the week commencing Monday, 31 January and are expected to be completed by mid-March 2022, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access and detours: pedestrian access will be maintained at all times via a detour along Regency Road and Pedder Crescent (refer to map). Please observe signage and directions from traffic controllers.
