Pedestrian Crossing Upgrade Christie Downs Railway Station - Update

We recently notified you of works being undertaken to activate the rail pedestrian crossing at Christie Downs Railway Station between Justin Crescent and Finbar Crescent, Christie Downs.

We wish to advise that intermittent night works scheduled to be completed in late July will now continue through to Friday, 5 August 2022, weather permitting, due to the recent wet weather. Hours of work will be between 5pm and 7am each night.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times via the existing crossing. Please observe signage and look both ways when crossing.

Some noise, dust and vibration may be experienced from construction machinery. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents and pedestrians during these works.

During night works, temporary lighting towers will be installed along the crossing to ensure safe working conditions for the team.

The final signalling commissioning and activation of the crossing is planned to occur between October and November 2022 and will take approximately two weeks to complete. Further information will be provided closer to the time.

There will be no impact to public transport services as part of these works.
