Pavement Rehabilitation Works

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler as part of the Roads of Strategic Importance program.

As part of this program, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is undertaking pavement rehabilitation works on the Sturt Highway at locations northeast of Gawler and west of Truro (see locality map overleaf).

Works are scheduled to commence on Monday, 27 March 2023 and will be completed in June 2023, weather permitting.

What to expect

Works will be undertaken between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. Some weekend work may be required.

Works will involve removing existing pavement and replacing it with new asphalt to ensure the long-term safety and integrity of the highway for all road users.

To safely facilitate these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works.

Outside of working hours a speed restriction of 60km will be in place, subject to on site conditions. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles. Access to properties will be maintained during the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.

Speed restrictions will remain in place for approximately 4-6 weeks on the newly resurfaced section of road to enable excess bitumen on the new surface to be worn to a safe texture level (this is in relation to the skid resistance of the road surface), prior to the posted speed limit being reinstated.
