Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade

Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junctions Night Works Notification

As part of the Mitcham Hills Corridor Upgrade, the South Australian Government is upgrading the Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junctions. This upgrade will increase capacity across the road network and improve road safety for all users.

As part of the project, utility service relocations works are required at the junction of **Main Road and Sheoak Road, Belair**.

What to expect

To minimise impacts to road users, these works will be undertaken at night from **7pm Tuesday**, **5 September 2023 until 6am Wednesday**, **6 September 2023**, weather permitting.

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. **Main Road will remain open to traffic at all times.**

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. No changes to public transport services are planned during these works.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling more intrusive works in the early evening. Individual service providers will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.
