Horrocks Highway Corridor Upgrade Early works notice – Sevenhill

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is continuing to undertake safety improvements on the Horrocks Highway.

This project forms part of the South Australian Rural Roads Safety Package, which is jointly funded (80:20) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Early works were paused temporarily due to inclement weather and are scheduled to re-commence on **Wednesday, 11 October 2023** and are expected to be completed in mid-November 2023, weather permitting.

Typically works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, from 7am to 6pm, weather permitting. Some weekend work may be required. During these times the highway will be reduced to a single lane with traffic controllers in place to control the direction of traffic.

Outside of working hours, the highway will re-open to a single lane of traffic in each direction with speed restrictions in place throughout the work area.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and follow the directions of traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

These works are expected to be completed in mid-November 2023. The Department appreciates your cooperation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
