Augusta Highway Upgrades

Clements Road junction

We are delivering infrastructure upgrades between Port Wakefield and Port Augusta to improve safety, connectivity and freight efficiency. These upgrades form part of the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade program jointly funded (80:20) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

What's happening:

We are upgrading the Augusta Highway junction at Clements Road, south of Crystal Brook. Following major works being completed in late 2023, finishing works including final surfacing and line marking are now required.

When

Monday 8 April 2024 for approximately seven days, weather permitting

Hours of operation

7am - 5:30pm Monday to Friday

Where

Augusta Highway and Clements Road junction south of Crystal Brook

How this affects you:

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Traffic controllers will be on site, to help manage the flow of traffic. Speed restrictions will also remain in place outside of working hours until completion.

Please follow the directions of onsite traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. **The Augusta Highway will remain open to traffic at all times.**

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.
