

Freight Highway Upgrade Program

Survey works – Port Wakefield Highway and Augusta Highway

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes. This includes the upgrade of three major highways (Augusta Highway, Stuart Highway and Dukes Highway) in South Australia.

What's happening:

We are undertaking engineering survey works on Port Wakefield Highway between Two Wells and Lower Light and on Augusta Highway between Port Germein and Port Augusta and between Port Pirie and Crystal Brook. These survey works will help inform our planning for this section of the highway.

How this affects you:

To safely undertake these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed restrictions will be in place on Augusta Highway and Port Wakefield Highway during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

We'll maintain access for properties throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to restrict driveway access temporarily.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during works.
