Works Notice

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, and urban roads, and footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia. The \$168 million program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over two years (2023-2025).

What's happening:

We are planning to construct a new pedestrian refuge on St Bernards Road, Rostrevor to improve safety and connection to the Fourth Creek Trail.

Site investigations and survey works are required to help us better understand the existing road conditions. This work will also help to inform our design and construction planning.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, there will be changes to traffic conditions. Please follow onsite signage and traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access for safety; however, traffic controllers will be on site to show you where to go. There may be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

Access for public transport will be maintained, however, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at <u>adelaidemetro.com.au</u>

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.
