

Grand Junction Road, Gepps Cross Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Commencement of works

We are making it safer for pedestrians and cyclists to cross Grand Junction Road.

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional and urban roads, footpaths and cycling paths around South Australia. This \$168 million program is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments over three years.

What's happening

We are installing a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (push button) on Grand Junction Road at the junction of Grand Junction Road and Montrose Avenue, Clearview.

Works will include installation of new traffic signals, upgrades to the footpath and centre median, and the relocation of Bus Stop 28, south side, Grand Junction Road.

This will improve bicycle and pedestrian safety and access to nearby sporting facilities, businesses and homes, while improving connectivity across Grand Junction Road.

How this affects you

Grand Junction Road will remain open at all times.

Early works including site investigation works, surveying and soil sampling will take place from 28 July 2025 for approximately 3 days between the hours of 9am and 4pm, with major works commencing from mid-August 2025, weather permitting.

Following completion of early works Bus Stop 28 – South Side will be permanently relocated approximately 50m north. There may be temporary interruption to services during this time. For the latest information please visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours, with speed restrictions remaining in place at all times. Two-way traffic on Grand Junction Road will be maintained at all times.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow the speed limits and signs.

To minimise traffic impacts some night works will be required during construction. Advance notice will be provided prior to the commencement of night works.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through the area. Some areas may have restricted access, with traffic controllers and on-site signage to guide you to alternative routes.

To safely undertake works, Montrose Avenue at the junction with Grand Junction Road will be closed intermittently throughout construction. Local access detours will be in place during this time. Please follow onsite signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained. Advance notice will be provided if temporary access restrictions are required.
