

# City Tram Extension Project

Weekend Works: 24 – 27 November 2017

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of weekend works planned on North Terrace between Pulteney Street and Gawler Place as part of the City Tram Extension. These works are scheduled to commence from **10pm on Friday 24 November** and be completed by **6am on Monday 27 November 2017**, weather permitting.

Works undertaken will include the laying of new tram tracks, concrete pouring, road resurfacing and line marking. Works will also include the continuing installation of new conduits by SA Power Networks.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic at all times. A 25km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period. Access to businesses, car parks and properties will be maintained throughout the works.
