



Main North Road and Nottage Terrace Intersection Upgrade

Service Relocation Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be upgrading the intersection of Main North Road and Nottage Terrace to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$19 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the South Australian and Australian governments.

As part of the project, the Department advises that utility services relocation works will be undertaken along Main North Road and Nottage Terrace to facilitate the intersection upgrade.

Timing of works:

Service relocation works will commence **from *Monday, 30 November 2020, between 7pm and 7am, each night** (no works on Saturday nights), **expected to be completed by 7am on Monday, 14 December 2020, weather permitting.** **Please note, this date is subject to change as further detail on COVID-19 restrictions are released.*

To safely facilitate the works and minimise impact to road users the works will be undertaken at night. The works being undertaken by APA Gas, Telstra, Optus and SA Water include asset alterations, excavation, trenching and reinstatement.

What to expect:

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works and every effort made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users.

For safety reasons there may be some restricted pedestrian and cycling access at times. There will be signage in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours when required. Pedestrians and cyclists are asked to observe signage and advised to take care when travelling through the area.

Individual service providers including Telecommunications, APA Gas, SA Power Networks and SA Water will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

Previously notified service relocation day works which commenced in September 2020, will continue during the day and are expected to be complete in early 2021, weather permitting.
