Tea Tree Plaza New Park 'n' Ride Project

The South Australian Government has committed \$43.5 million to the construction of a new four level (ground floor plus three upper floors) Park 'n' Ride at the Tea Tree Plaza Interchange. The new facility will connect to and expand the existing Park 'n' Ride, increasing the number of parking spaces available from 700 to approximately 1,200.

The upgrade aims to meet demand for Park 'n' Ride commuters and to increase public transport usage in the north-eastern suburbs.

Project timing

To facilitate the construction of the Park 'n' Ride, site clearance and civil works began in mid-November 2022. These works are now complete.

The project team will return to site on Monday, 9 January 2023 to recommence works. Major construction activities will commence on 10 January 2023.

The new facility will be open to the public by mid-2024, weather permitting.

Construction activities

The next stage of construction will involve works to establish the substructure.

Substructure works will involve the installation of foundation piling and footings.

'Piling' provides vertical support to a structure by transferring loads into stable soil or rock. The reinforced steel cages embedded in the piling create an effective bond for mass concrete footings. 'Footings' sit on top of piling and will transfer loads from the main structure to the piling.

This work will involve the use of piling rigs, excavators, and concrete trucks.

These works prepare the site for construction of the main structure.

Construction impacts
