Works notice

We are making it safer for pedestrians to cross St Vincent Street, Port Adelaide

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional and urban roads, footpaths and cycling paths around South Australia. This \$168 million program is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments over three years.

What's happening

A raised safety platform is being installed at the existing Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on St Vincent Street, between Robe Street and Marryatt Street, Port Adelaide.

A raised safety platform is an elevated section of road that can accompany pedestrian actuated (push button) crossings. Drivers must slow down on approach to the platform and stop upon a red signal.

The raised platform encourages motorists to slow down on the approach of the crossing and increases the awareness and safety for pedestrians and cyclists. A concept design can be viewed overleaf.

How this affects you

To minimise traffic impacts, the majority of works will be undertaken at night.

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during night works, with speed restrictions remaining in place at all times. Two-way traffic on St Vincent Street will be maintained at all times.

Please plan your trip, be cautious around workers and follow the speed limits and signs.

On-street parking on both sides of St Vincent Street between Robe Street and Marryatt Street will be restricted for the duration of the works.
