


Fact Sheet

We are relocating water, sewerage, gas and communications services along South Road, ahead of major construction works for the \$812 million Australian and South Australian government funded project.

These preliminary works will create a construction area between the Port River Expressway and Regency Road clear of services, while simultaneously ensuring the provision of electricity, gas, communications and water supply to this important commercial and industrial precinct.

Where low voltage electricity mains (the line from the street to each property) is scheduled to be relocated, ETSA will consult directly with each customer about the timing of this work to minimise inconvenience. When relocating the main feeder power lines (66KV) ETSA will put these underground.

Service relocation crews will be on site between the Port River Expressway and Regency Road through until June 2011. While service relocations are underway, advanced warning signs and speed restrictions will be in place, with road users asked to observe the local traffic controls that protect traffic and the work crews.
