

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Works Notification

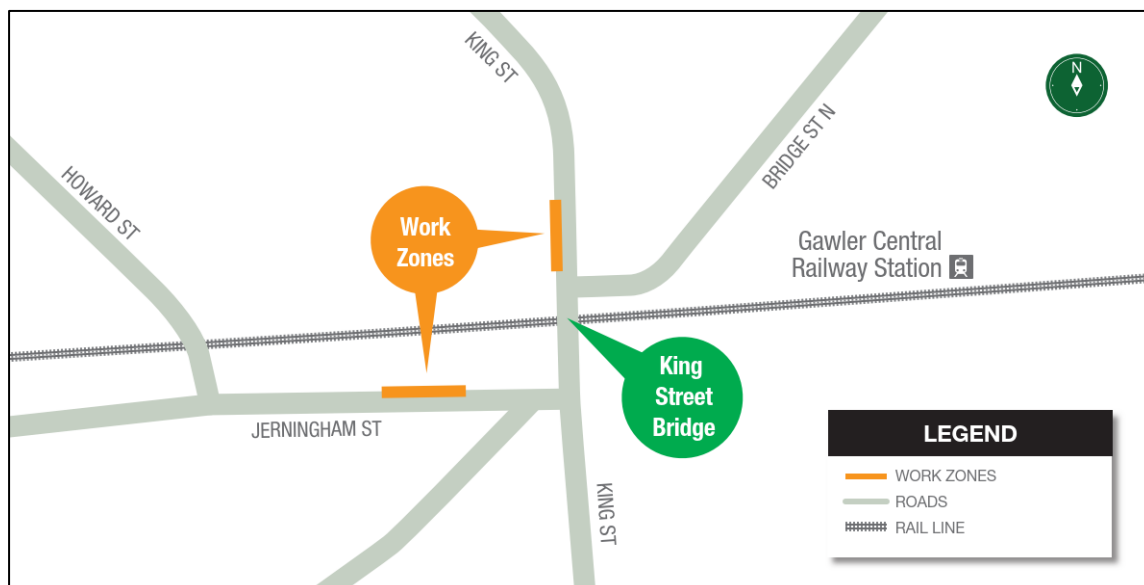
As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken in the vicinity of King Street Bridge, near the Gawler rail corridor.

Location: Jerningham Street and King Street, Gawler, in the vicinity of the King Street Bridge (refer to map).

When: Between 7am and 7pm, from Monday, 12 August to Friday, 23 August, intermittently (weather permitting). Note, no works will occur on weekends.

Activities will include:

- Service locating, and borehole drilling works to collect soil samples to assist with the project design.
- Work crews may return to each site multiple times over the period to complete the works.



Traffic management:

- Speed and lane restrictions will apply in the vicinity of works with signage and traffic management in place to advise motorists of the changed conditions.
- Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses.
