Gawler Rail Electrification Project

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to advise that the Gawler Rail Electrification Project to electrify the network from Adelaide to Gawler, is now underway.

The \$615 million Commonwealth and State funded project will deliver faster, safer and more reliable rail services. The electrified Gawler line will be a modern, environmentally friendly and efficient train service that will encourage more people to leave the car at home and take public transport. DPTI has announced Lendlease as the design and construction contractor for this project.

What the project involves

The electrification of the line from Adelaide to Gawler will help create approximately 225 jobs during construction. The works include:

- installation of the 25kV overhead wiring system including masts and gantries;
- installation of a new signalling system;
- installation of a new fibre optic communications system cable;
- acquisition of 15 additional, three-car electric trains (introduced in stages following completion of the electrification works);
- fencing of the rail corridor for improved safety;
- vegetation trimming/removal and other works necessary to enable the electrification to proceed; and
- services relocations.

Project timing and scheduled changes to rail services

The construction schedule has been coordinated to balance the needs of commuters, road users, residents and businesses.

Early works have commenced, including service relocations, with main construction works planned to commence late 2018. The project is scheduled for completion in late 2020.

To minimise disruption to businesses and residents during the project, the works program will be undertaken in a combination of day and night works. Advance notice will be provided of night works.

Some short-term line closures will be scheduled during the quieter commuter periods, for example school holidays, when there is less of a demand on the line. There may also be times when reduced services will occur during construction works. Substitute buses will be in place to accommodate commuters during the short-term closures and Adelaide Metro will provide advanced notification of any changes to rail services.

Early works - what you need to know

Survey works, geotechnical investigations and service relocations may occur in your area over the coming months and have been scheduled to minimise disruptions to train services, ensure public safety and the safety of project workers. Some of these works will be undertaken outside of the rail corridor and will mostly occur during the day but some nights works may be required.

Businesses and residents in the vicinity of these early works will be notified in advance and access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
