



Main South Road Duplication Project

Site Investigation Works

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed a total of \$560 million to fund the Fleurieu Connections Main South Road and Victor Harbor Road duplication projects, to be delivered by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department). These projects will result in safer and faster journeys for motorists and provide a vital boost for local tourism, communities and support hundreds of jobs each year during construction.

The Department is continuing site investigation works for the Main South Road Duplication Project.

Site investigations are required to better understand the existing conditions. These works will take place intermittently over the coming months. Works will include:

- locating underground services; and
- geotechnical investigations.

In order to minimise the impact to road users, the works will be undertaken each night on the intersection of Main South Road, Maslin Beach Road and Tatachilla Road from **Monday, 25 October to Friday, 5 November 2021**, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 7pm and 7am. No works will be undertaken on Saturday and Sunday nights.

All roads will remain open during this work. To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Minor delays may be experienced, so please plan ahead.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses, as much as practically possible.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Pedestrian access will not be affected during these works. There is no change to public transport services.
