

# South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrades

## Early Works Notification - Mylor

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading a series of bridges and culverts across regional South Australia to extend the service life of the structures and improve safety for road users.

As part of this program, the Department is replacing the bridge at Aldgate Creek and the culvert over Leslie Creek on Strathalbyn Road, Mylor.

Works for the Aldgate Creek bridge are jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments as part of the Bridges Renewal Program. Works for the culvert at Leslie Creek are funded by the South Australian Government as part of the Bridge Stimulus Package.

Early works, at both locations, including service relocations and vegetation management and removal, will commence from late August 2022, and are expected to be completed in September 2022, weather permitting. These works will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Fridays and between 7am and 3pm on Saturdays.

Impacts to vegetation have been carefully considered and will be minimised wherever practically possible.

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Road users are asked to please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works, wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Major construction at both locations is scheduled to commence in September 2022, with completion expected in early 2023, weather permitting. Further information about the timing of construction works and the planned traffic management will be provided in advance of works commencing.
