

# Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

## Main Road, Cherry Gardens Safety Improvements

As part of the State Government's election commitments, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is planning safety upgrade works on Main Road, Cherry Gardens between Black Road and Chandlers Hill Road.

This project forms part of the \$150 million Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package which includes a range of road improvements to support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience in the Adelaide Hills.

The Department is in the planning phase for this section of Main Road and is investigating safety improvement options such as safety barrier installations, better road signage, pavement works, road widening, vegetation management to improve driver sightlines, shoulder sealing and speed limits.

Local insights will play an important role to help inform the design of this upgrade. The Department is inviting community members to have their say on what they see as the safety and productivity challenges and priorities for this area.
