Ground investigation works

The South Australian Government is designing, building and operating a new Adelaide Aquatic Centre in the Adelaide City northern Park Lands at Pardipardinyilla / Denise Norton Park (Park 2).

To assist with project planning, ground investigation works will be undertaken on the site of the new centre at Park 2 and in the existing centre carpark.

Work will involve creating a series of small temporary boreholes to better understand ground conditions.

Timing

The majority of the investigation activities will be undertaken from Monday 4 September 2023 and be completed by Friday 8 September 2023, weather permitting.

Some additional investigation activities will also be undertaken in late September 2023.

What to expect

Some sections of the oval to the south of the existing Aquatic Centre in Park 2 (including the soccer pitches) and some car spaces within the existing Adelaide Aquatic Centre car park, will be temporarily cordoned off while ground investigation works are in progress.

Car park investigation activities will be undertaken during non-peak carpark user periods to minimise the impact. Please observe traffic control that may temporarily be in place.

There will be no restrictions to pedestrian or cycling pathways.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Works have been coordinated with the City of Adelaide to ensure Park 2 tenants are informed and the relevant permits have been obtained.

We appreciate your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
