Temporary closure of Maple Avenue, Tonsley



As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, road construction, drainage and electrical conduit installation works will be undertaken at the Maple Avenue junction with Sturt Road, Tonsley.

Maple Avenue will be temporarily closed at the junction with Sturt Road during the works, which will be undertaken at night between 8pm and 6am on the below dates:

Monday 18 September 2017
Tuesday 19 September 2017
Wednesday 20 September 2017

Excavators, a roller, a crane, trucks, light towers, a profiler and an asphalt machine will be used.

Traffic management

- Vehicles will be detoured via Birch Crescent and Oak Avenue
- Pedestrian access along Sturt Road and Maple Avenue will be maintained
- Access to properties will be maintained
- Lane speed restrictions will apply on Sturt Road in the vicinity of the works.
- Signage will alert motorists to the changed traffic conditions.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and disruption while these works are undertaken and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed and lane restrictions when travelling through the area.
