

Thomas Food International access project

Dear Property Owner / Tenant,

We are writing to inform you that the Australian and South Australian Governments are funding \$14 million for the road infrastructure necessary to support Thomas Foods International's new state-of-the-art meat processing facility, north of Murray Bridge.

The new meat processing facility will be constructed on a greenfield site owned by Thomas Foods approximately six kilometres north of Murray Bridge between Wilkins Road and Temora Lane.

The project will construct a new road junction with turning lanes on Mannum Road and approximately two kilometres of new public (local) road into the facility to provide safe access for both staff and high productivity heavy vehicles.

The new road and junction will minimise impacts on existing local access roads.

Planning and design works are currently underway, and construction works are planned to start in early 2020.
