

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

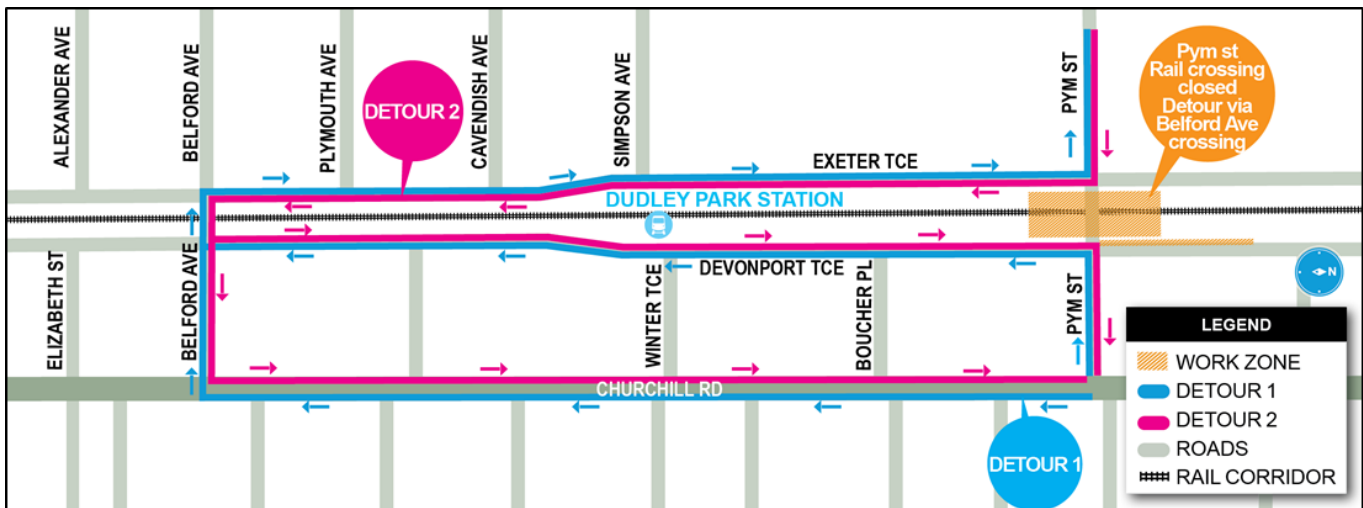
Pym Street, Prospect - level crossing temporary closure

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken at the Pym Street level crossing requiring a temporary closure with detours in place.

Location: Pym Street level crossing, within the rail corridor adjacent Exeter and Devonport Terraces, Prospect (refer to map).

When: From 2am, Saturday, 11 April, until midnight Wednesday, 15 April, weather permitting

Traffic management: Detours to the Belford Avenue level crossing and speed restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Signage and traffic management will advise motorists of changed conditions.



What you can expect:

- Noise from construction machinery used to undertake drilling and trenching works and pit installation.
- Construction plant equipment including a hydro-vacuum machine, excavator, crane and lighting towers A truck with equipment accompanied by 2-4 light vehicles.
- Project personnel operating within the rail corridor.
- The level crossing will be closed to traffic during the works, with a detour in place. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the works.
- Traffic management crews will ensure access to your property is maintained at all times.
