



Nairne Intersection Upgrade

Early Works Notification

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improved safety and traffic efficiency through the construction of a four-way, single lane roundabout realigning the Woodside Road and Saleyard Road T-junctions with the Old Princes Highway, Nairne. The State Government has committed \$12 million to this project which is being delivered as an election commitment as part of the Adelaide Hills Intersections Upgrade Initiative.

As part of the project, the Department advises that service relocation works are being undertaken along Old Princes Highway, Woodside Road and Saleyard Road to facilitate the upgrade. These works are being undertaken in stages.

Timing of works

The service relocation works commenced in late March 2021, and are expected to be completed by mid-2021, weather permitting. The majority of works are being undertaken each day, Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with the potential for some weekend works.

What to expect

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the T-junctions will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Individual service providers including SA Power Networks and Telecommunication providers will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

Please note that during these works the bus stops in the vicinity of the works along Old Princes Highway and Woodside Road may require temporary relocation, however public transport services will remain operational. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au when required.
