

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Hawker Street, Torrens Road, Belford Avenue and Pym Street level crossing temporary closure

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Hawker Street, Torrens Road, Belford Avenue and Pym Street level crossings will be temporarily closed to complete overhead wiring works. All four crossings must be closed at the same time to enable a full length of overhead wire to be installed.

Location: works will be undertaken within the rail corridor between North Adelaide and Islington railway stations. To ensure the works can be undertaken safely, the Hawker Street, Torrens Road, Belford Avenue and Pym Street level crossings will be temporarily closed to all traffic while works are carried out.

When: works will be undertaken at night to minimise impacts to traffic during peak times. Hours of work are:

- 12am to 6am Saturday, 19 June 2021
- 12am to 6am Sunday, 20 June 2021

All four level crossings closed at these times.

*Please note revised works times as at 16 June 2021.

Traffic management and detours: Detours will be in place to direct motorists to alternative crossing points via Port Road and Regency Road (refer to map). Speed restrictions will also apply. Please observe signage, speed restrictions and traffic controllers.

Access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained at all times. Pedestrians will be assisted to cross by staff on site (if safe to do so) or directed to the nearest safe crossing point.


















Notification - June 2021 Rail

Some noise can be expected from construction machinery. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents and businesses during these works as much as is practically possible.
