

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

King Street Bridge - Construction update

The Australian and South Australian governments are jointly funding the electrification and modernisation of the Gawler rail line which will deliver a faster, cleaner and more reliable service, delivering an electrified network through Adelaide from Gawler to Seaford.

Works are continuing in the King Street Bridge area. As part of the project, the King Street Bridge has now been removed and is being replaced with a new pedestrian bridge.

Pedestrian bridge installation and temporary road closure

The new King Street pedestrian bridge is scheduled for installation the week beginning 29 November 2021. To safely facilitate these works, the intersection of Jerningham Street, Queen Street and King Street will be temporarily closed to vehicles and pedestrians from **7am Monday**, **29 November 2021**, **for approximately two weeks, weather permitting**. Within this period, works will continue to occur Monday to Saturday, 7am to 7pm. To safely undertake these works, detours will be in place directing motorists to alternative access routes (refer to map).





A temporary pedestrian detour will also be in place around the works site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage.

Residents may notice some noise, dust and vibration from machinery and vehicle movements while works are underway. Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

The new bridge is being fabricated locally and will be lifted into place. The concrete bridge deck will be poured following the installation of the bridge. Prior to the new bridge opening, works are required to relocate and attach the utility services to the bridge, followed by kerb and asphalt works.

Following installation of the bridge, permanent relocation of the SA Water and gas main will occur, as well as the installation of new light poles. Interruptions to utility services and after hours works, if required, will be notified in advance by your service provider.
