

# Nottage Terrace and North East Road Intersection Upgrade

## Night Works and temporary traffic changes

**The Australian and South Australian governments are jointly funding (50:50) the \$6 million Nottage Terrace and North East Road Intersection Upgrade. The upgrade is expected to support approximately 10 full-time equivalent jobs over the life of the project.**

North East Road is a major commuter corridor providing an important connection between the CBD and Adelaide's north-eastern suburbs. This intersection upgrade will increase the capacity for vehicles turning left onto North East Road from Nottage Terrace, creating an overall improvement of traffic flow for vehicles travelling between Main North Road and North East Road along Nottage Terrace.

Night works for the installation of drainage, road lighting, traffic signals and asphalt pavement will be undertaken in various locations through and around the intersection and adjacent side streets from **early February 2023 to early April 2023**. These night works will take place between the hours of **7pm and 6am, Sundays to Thursdays with intermittent Friday night works**. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling more intrusive works in the early evening, where possible.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times; however, a short closure of D'Erlanger Avenue will be required each night from **Friday, 24 February to Tuesday, 27 February 2023** (see map overleaf). **Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, please see overleaf for temporary lane closure details**. Please plan ahead to allow extra travel time and take care when workers and traffic controllers are on site, observe speed limits, detours and lane restrictions when travelling through the area.

For safety reasons there will be a pedestrian and cyclist detour around the work area. Please take care when travelling through the area and pay particular attention to the access and/or detour signage.

Public transport services will not be affected during the works, however if required, advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website [www.adelaidemetro.com.au](http://www.adelaidemetro.com.au)

The project team will contact individual property owners if their access is affected by the works. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

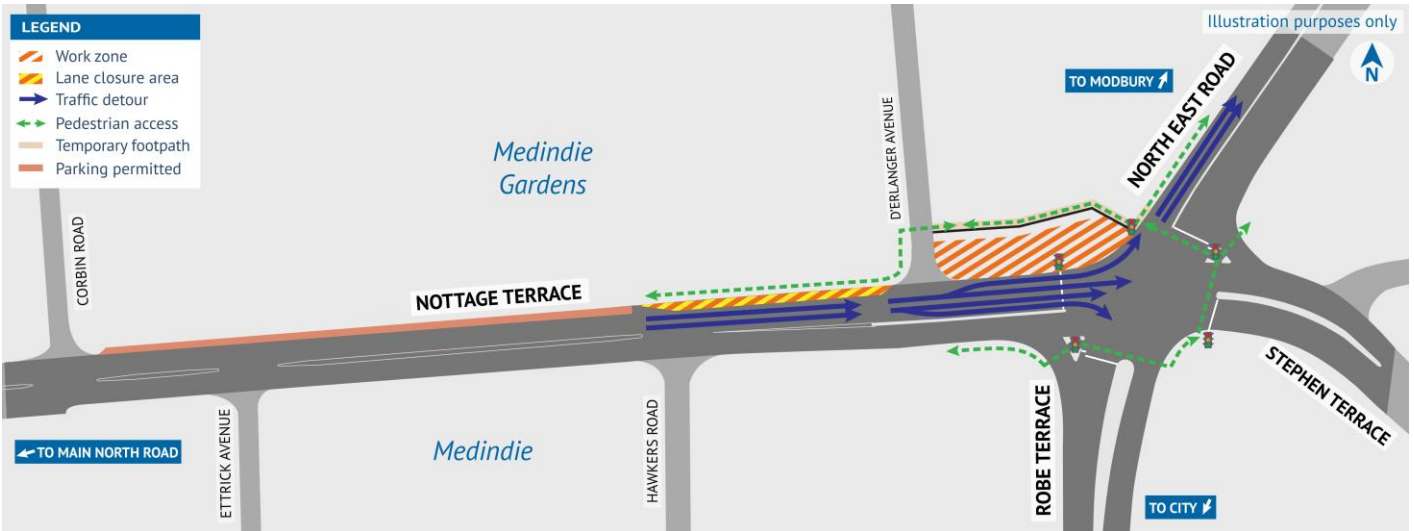
