

South Eastern Freeway, Verdun to Hahndorf

Works Notice

Road resurfacing works will recommence on the South Eastern Freeway. These works will improve the safety and amenity of the road for all users.

What's happening:

General maintenance activities, including resurfacing and asphalt patching, are required at multiple locations to improve the road surface and drivability at the three bridge locations.

How this affects you:

To undertake this work safely, there will be speed and lane restrictions in place. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, speed restrictions will need to remain in place, until completion.

During the works there will be some noise and dust from time to time but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odour which is normal during asphalt work.

Reduced speed limits will be in effect throughout the area for up to three weeks after the asphalt work is complete. This is essential to allow for any excess bitumen to wear off to a safe level.
