

# Recognition of prior learning (RPL) for temporary traffic management (TTM) qualification

## What is recognition of prior learning (RPL)?

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) involves an assessment of your knowledge and experience of your previous and current skills and compares them to the requirements of an Austroads temporary traffic management training program (skill set).

If you can clearly show that you have already gained the equivalent skills and knowledge, and that skills and knowledge is current, then you may be granted recognition of prior learning for an Austroads temporary traffic management training program (skill set). The evidence you provide must include knowledge, experience and skills gained.

## What evidence is required for RPL?

Approved evidence required for RPL include:

- Relevant licenses and/or tickets
- Resume or work history
- Diaries/task sheets/job sheets/logbooks
- Site training records
- References/letters from current and/or previous employers/supervisors
- Certificates from in-house or formal training courses completed

## Pre-requisites for applying for RPL

Each skill set has a pre-requisite entry requirement. You need to discuss with an approved registered training provider what the pre-requisites are prior to enrolling for the qualification skill set you wish to attain. You can find list of approved training providers [here](#).

## Recognition of prior learning models for TTM qualifications

### Full RPL Process

Collect evidence for your application:

- Any licences/tickets/authorisations
- Resume or details of work history
- Industry currency – worked in WZTM in last 12 months
- Certificates from in-house or formal training courses completed
- Diaries/task sheets/job sheets/logbooks
- Site training records
- Site competencies held record
- References/letters from current and/or previous employers/supervisors in the TTM industry

You will need to complete a written assessment with a registered training organisation. You will be required to have an understanding of the Austroads Guides – Parts 1 – 10.

You will have a competency conversation with an assessor who needs to establish that you have the skills and experience required.

### Blended RPL Process

- You will attend the classroom training along with practitioners.
- You will complete the written assessment and simulated practical assessment.
- Then you can RPL your post course practical assessment with evidence of your experience.
- You are required to have a competency conversation with an assessor.

If you are successful in all aspects of this process you will be issued the new qualification for which you have applied.
