Dukes Highway – works notice

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

This includes the upgrade of Stuart Highway, Augusta Highway, and Dukes Highway.

What's happening

We are undertaking resurfacing works at multiple locations along the Dukes Highway, between Tintinara and Bordertown.

Following completion of the resurfacing works in early August 2025, we will be undertaking Audio Tactile Line Marking (ATLM) installation at suitable locations along the Dukes Highway. ATLM is used to reduce rural 'run-off-road' road crashes by providing a noise (audio) and vibratory (tactile) warning to road users.

These improvements will enhance the road surface and increase safety for all road users.

How this affects you

Dukes Highway will remain open to traffic at all times.

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions.
