

Horrocks Highway culvert upgrade

Traffic update

We are improving safety and freight efficiency on the Horrocks Highway

The Horrocks Highway culvert replacement project is jointly funded (80:20) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

What's happening

Major works to upgrade an existing culvert on the Horrocks Highway, approximately 2kms north of Rhynie, are nearly complete. Once completed this upgrade will improve flood resilience, safety and heavy vehicle capacity along this important freight corridor.

Following completion of major works in mid-June 2025, normal traffic conditions will be returned to Horrocks Highway with all restrictions lifted.

How this affects you

Two-way traffic on Horrocks Highway will be reinstated under posted speed limits from mid-June 2025.

Finishing works, including final sealing and line marking, will be undertaken during the warmer months later this year. Advance notice will be provided prior to the commencement of these works.
