

North-South Corridor Darlington Upgrade Project

Laffer Triangle access changes February 2018



As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, access in the Laffer Triangle will change from 7am on Monday 26 February 2018, as outlined below.

- The new road connection (Flinders Drive Extension) between Sturt Road and Laffer Drive will be temporarily closed for approximately three months to allow for remaining pavement, utility service and drainage works to be undertaken
- Vehicles wishing to access Hugh Cairns Avenue will be required to do so via Laffer Drive

Please see the plan overleaf for further details.

Footpath access will continue to be available along Hugh Cairns Avenue and Laffer Drive.

The full length of the Flinders Drive Extension (from Sturt Road to Flinders Drive) is expected to be open to traffic in mid 2018. The new signalised intersection at Sturt Road and Birch Crescent will come into operation at the same time.
