Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

Night Works Notification

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Night works involving trenching for service utilities and new drainage infrastructure for the Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade Project will continue in stages throughout October.

The Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade Project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian Governments. The \$60 million project will improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users.

The service relocation and drainage installation works along Goodwood Road, Springbank Road and Daws Road are being undertaken to facilitate the new intersection realignment. While the majority of these works are being undertaken during the day, night works are also required.

Night works will be undertaken from **Wednesday**, **7 October for approximately 3 nights** and from **Sunday**, **25 October for approximately 6 nights**, weather permitting. In order to minimise the impact to road users and ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, works will be undertaken at night **between 7pm** and **7am**.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site, and observe speed and lane restrictions and signage when travelling through the area.

Excavators, tippers, compaction equipment and lighting towers will be used during these works, and some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disruption as much as practically possible.

Access to properties during these works will be maintained, however at times this will be under the assistance of traffic controllers. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Individual service providers such as SA Power Networks, SA Water, Telecommunications providers and Gas Authorities will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
