NIGHT WORKS ON VICTOR HARBOR ROAD

From next week, preliminary works for the McLaren Vale Overpass will begin.

These works, largely service relocations, are the precursor to construction of the overpass.

The works will involve relocation of electricity, water, and telecommunications infrastructure both, aerial and underground and will enable continuity of service throughout construction.

To minimise traffic disruption, construction crews from the Department for Transport, Energy and Infrastructure (DTEI) will work overnight.

Electronic warning signs will be positioned at key locations to advise road users in advance of the works.

Some lane and speed restrictions of 25km/h will be in place to protect workers and road users.

DTEI thanks motorists for their patience while these essential infrastructure works are carried out.

Major construction works on this project, jointly funded by the Australian and State governments, are expected to follow completion of these service relocations.
