



Nairne Intersection Upgrade

Night Works Notification and Road Closure

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improved safety and traffic efficiency through the construction of a four-way, single lane roundabout realigning the Woodside Road and Saleyard Road T-junctions with the Old Princes Highway, Nairne. The State Government committed \$13 million to this project which is being delivered as part of the Adelaide Hills Intersections Upgrade Initiative.

Works are continuing to complete the construction of kerbs and footpaths and install new street lighting and pedestrian fencing. Whilst the majority of these works are being undertaken during the day, night works will be required to place the final wearing course layer of asphalt and complete line marking.

These night works will be undertaken from Wednesday, 8 December 2021, until Thursday, 16 December 2021, weather permitting, between 6pm and 7am. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.

To safely undertake these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. In addition, the following temporary road closure will be in place:

- **On Wednesday, 8 December and Thursday, 9 December 2021, between 8pm and 6am - access to Woodside Road will be closed** between N Railway Terrace and the new roundabout. A temporary detour will in place via North Road. Please see detour map below.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Public transport services will remain operational, however, bus stops in the vicinity of the works, along Old Princes Highway and Woodside Road, may require temporary relocation. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au when required.

The project is expected to be complete early 2022, weather permitting.

The Department appreciates your patience whilst these important works are undertaken.
