

Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Asphalt weekend works – Stage 3

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, asphalt works are required to be undertaken within the new intersection. These works are being undertaken in stages, across a series of full weekends throughout the month of February 2023.

The first and second stages of works have been completed, with the final stage of asphaltting to be undertaken in the south-eastern quadrant of the intersection, from **7pm Friday, 17 February, both day and night until 6am Monday, 20 February 2023, weather permitting.**

What to expect

To safely facilitate these works and manage traffic flows, speed and lane restrictions will be in place across the intersection with different traffic arrangements in place during night shifts and day shifts across the weekend. Please see details below:

The following traffic arrangements will be in place during **night shifts, Friday, 17 and Saturday 18, February between 7pm – 7am and Sunday, 19 February between 7pm and 6am:**

- Ringarooma Avenue will be closed at the junction with Fullarton Road. Local access will be via Clinton Avenue and Hexham Avenue or Cross Road and Hexham Avenue;
- Walter Young Avenue will be closed at Fullarton Road. Motorists will be required to access the University via Claremont Avenue or Waite Road; and
- traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Night works' for details of the above arrangements.

The following traffic arrangements will be in place **during day shifts Saturday, 18 and Sunday, 19 February between 7am and 7pm:**

- Ringarooma Avenue will be closed at the junction with Fullarton Road. Local access will be via Clinton Avenue and Hexham Avenue or Cross Road and Hexham Avenue;
- Walter Young Avenue will be closed at Fullarton Road. Motorists will be required to access the University via Claremont Avenue or Waite Road; and
- two lanes of traffic will operate in each direction.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Day works' for details of the above arrangements.

The pedestrian crossing on Fullarton Road, on the southern side of the intersection, will be closed during the works for safety reasons. Pedestrians will need to use the Cross Road crossings (east or west) to then access the pedestrian crossing on the northern side of Fullarton Road.

Traffic controllers will be on-site to assist pedestrians and signage will be in place. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

Emergency services vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Bus stops will not be impacted during this stage of works.

Motorists and local residents are reminded that right turn movements at Ringarooma Avenue, Euston Avenue and Hexham Avenue have now been permanently removed.

Ringarooma Avenue closure

Ringarooma Avenue will be closed at the junction with Fullarton Road from 7am Friday, 17 February until 6am Monday, 20 February, in order to complete new kerbing and surface drainage works. Local access will be via Clinton Avenue and Hexham Avenue or Cross Road and Hexham Avenue.

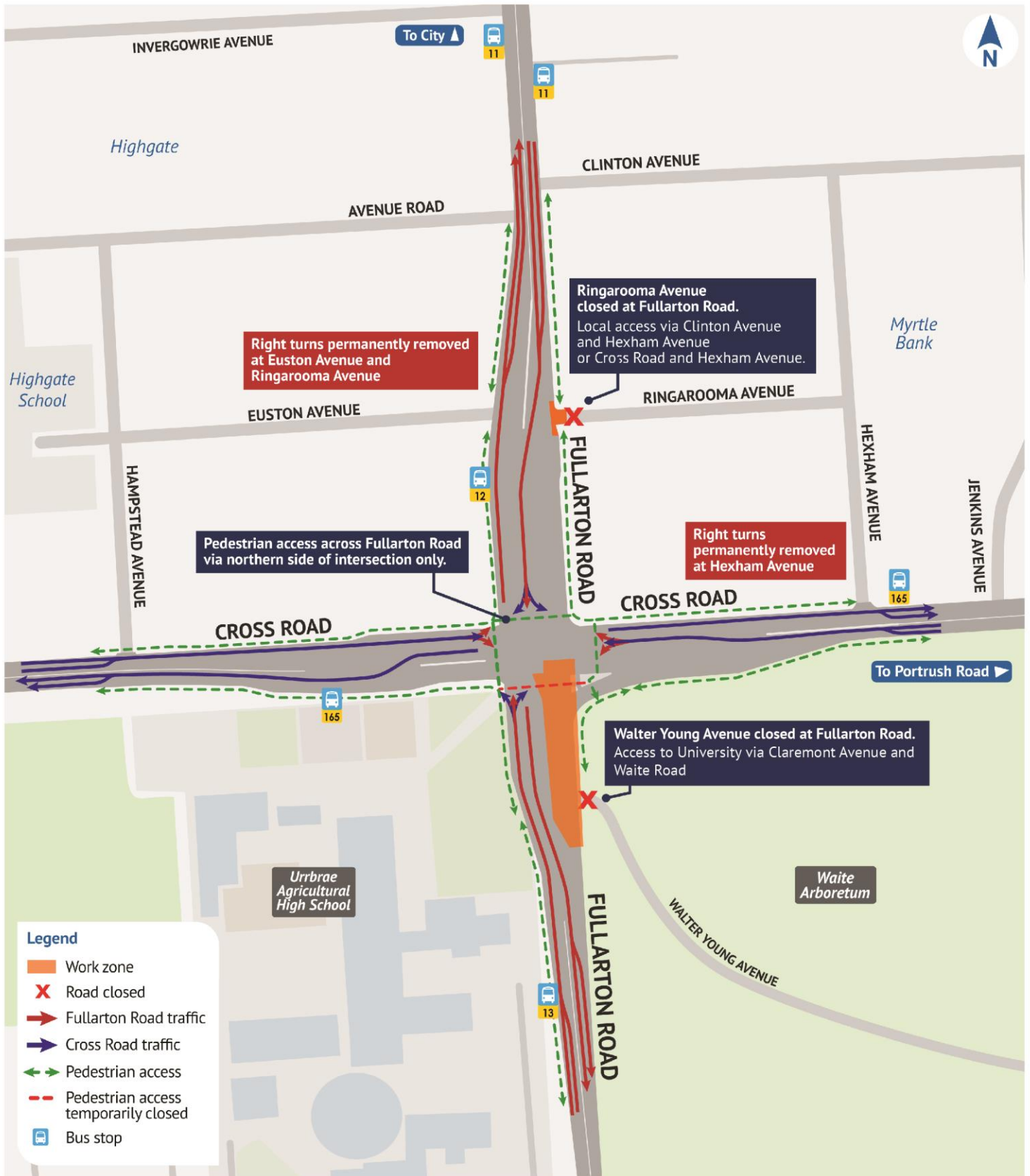

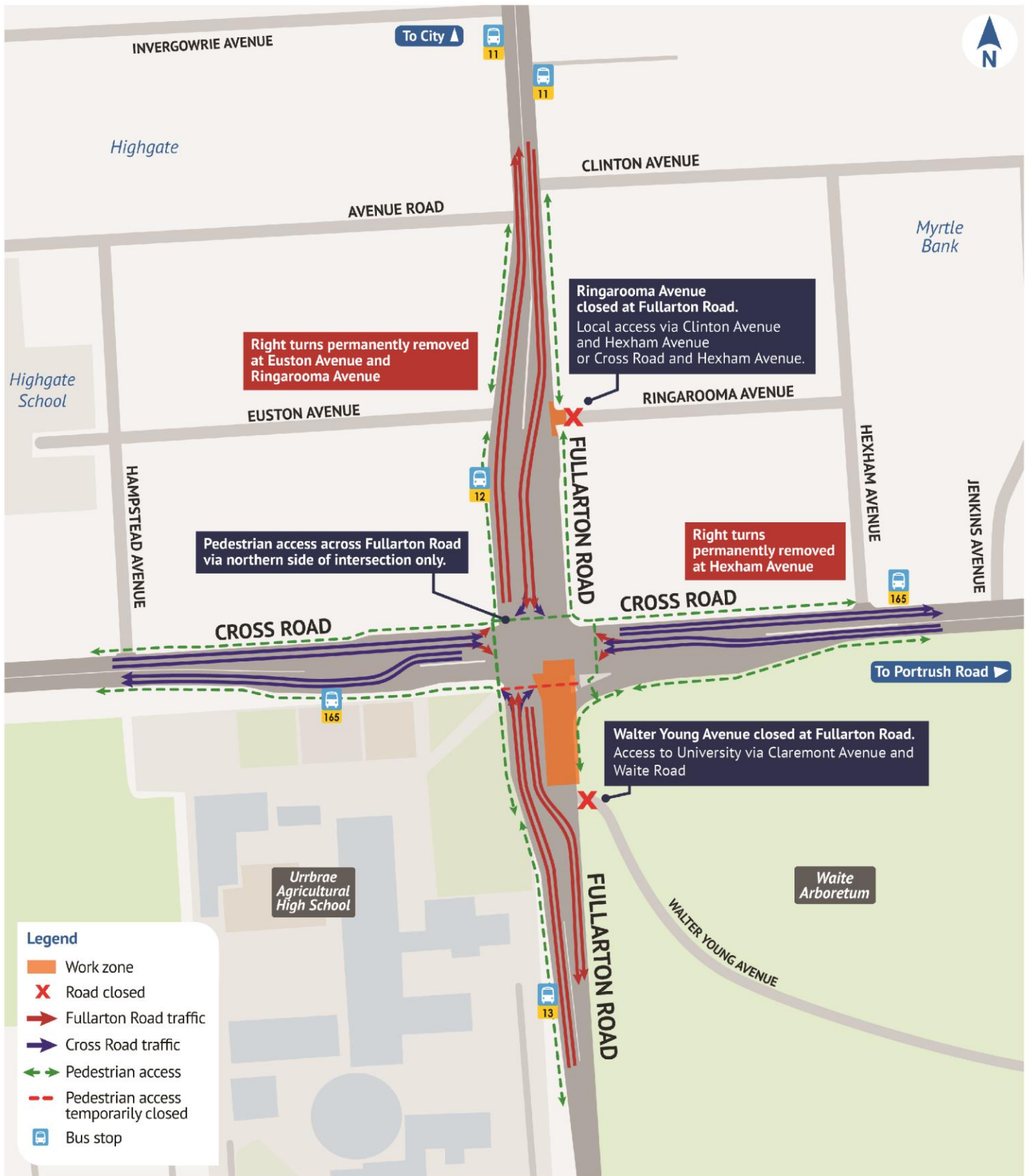
