Crafers Park 'n' Ride

Project Update

Australian Government South committed \$6 million to deliver additional parking at the Crafers Park 'n' Ride.

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is currently in the early design stage of the project.

Background

Park 'n' Ride facilities offer customers a place to park their car or bike, and transfer to public transport to complete their journey. These facilities reduce the reliance on private vehicles, reducing congestion and environmental impacts.

Key objectives

The Crafers Park 'n' Ride is the closest Park 'n' Ride to the city in the Adelaide Hills region and this upgrade will encourage use of public transport and reduce private car use. The key objectives of the project are to:

- increase Park 'n' Ride capacity and allow more people to access public transport;
- improve safety, security and amenity; and
- improve access to the existing bus stops and parking.

What is proposed?

A new Park 'n' Ride will be built to the southeast of the existing Crafers Park 'n' Ride, next to the Crafers off ramp (westbound) and the South Eastern Freeway.

There will be 85 new car parking spaces, including two accessible bays and motorcycle parking. Some vegetation removal is needed to accommodate the works but will be minimised where possible. New landscaping and trees will be planted as part of the project. Please refer to concept plans attached for more details.

The location for the expansion of the Crafers Park 'n' Ride was selected as it:

- increases car parking close to existing bus stops;
- reduces impact to bus services, nearby residents and businesses during construction; and
- allows the existing northern car park to continue to operate at full capacity during construction.

Key features

- access to the new Park 'n' Ride will be through the existing roundabout at the intersection of Waverley Ridge Road and the Crafers on and off ramps (westbound);
- exiting from the car park will be through the Crafers off ramp (westbound);
- new lighting and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) will be installed;
- a new path to connect existing footpaths and carpark will be established; and
- landscaping and urban design treatments will be implemented.

What's next?

We would like to seek your feedback about the concept design for the project. Please provide your feedback by Friday 18 August 2023.

Feedback received and site investigation activities will be used to inform the detailed design. Construction is anticipated to commence in late 2023 and be completed by mid-2024, weather permitting.
