

Pedestrian refuge upgrade and Tour Down Under 2024 reinstatement works

Gorge Road Athelstone

We are undertaking pedestrian refuge upgrade works on Gorge Road, Athelstone. Works will involve the upgrade and reinstatement of a pedestrian refuge to ensure safety for school children and all users.

What's happening:

We are reinstating and upgrading the pedestrian refuge on Gorge Road near Manresa Court, Athelstone following the completion of the Tour Down Under. The pedestrian refuge will be upgraded to meet current Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) standards including new ramps and handrails.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs.

You will still be able to access businesses and homes. If we need to limit access, we'll let property owners know ahead of time.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access for safety reasons. We'll put up signs to guide you to other routes if needed.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.
