

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Mount Barker Road and Strathalbyn Road

We are delivering upgrades to key strategic arterial roads in the Adelaide Hills. The improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience.

The \$150 million Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening:

Investigation works are required to support planning works currently underway as part of this package. Investigations include engineering surveys to understand the current condition and geometry of the road.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours, where required, with works moving progressively along Mount Barker Road and Strathalbyn Road.

Please follow onsite signage and traffic controllers that will be in place to manage traffic flow and ensure motorists, cyclists and pedestrians can safely navigate around our work areas.

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.
