

As part of the State Government's election commitments, we are working to improve safety and reduce waiting times at the Happy Valley Drive and Chandlers Hill Road intersection and the Happy Valley Drive and Windebanks Road junction.

In late 2022 we sought feedback from the community and key stakeholders to better understand your experiences at these sections of Happy Valley Drive.

Thank you to everyone who provided their thoughts. We received 655 pieces of feedback.

Key themes of the feedback included concerns relating to queuing, delays, access and motorist and pedestrian safety.

We are now seeking your feedback on the proposed concepts. **Please share your feedback by Friday 19 April 2024.** Your insights will be used to then finalise the concepts. We have used these local insights, along with our technical analysis, to develop proposed concepts to improve the Happy Valley Drive and Chandlers Hill Road intersection and the Happy Valley Drive and Windebanks Road junction.

There is currently no funding to deliver these proposed upgrades. Future funding decisions will be considered based on community feedback and further technical investigations.



Happy Valley Drive and Chandlers Hill Road Intersection

A two-lane roundabout at Happy Valley Drive and Chandlers Hill Road intersection is proposed. The design includes two lanes on each approach and two circulating lanes. The upgrade would include new kerb and gutter, line marking, pavement construction and resurfacing, as well as new and upgraded lighting. The pedestrian refuges are planned to remain at each approach. There is also an opportunity to relocate bus stop 39 on Chandlers Hill Road further west with a new pedestrian refuge to improve safety for people crossing the road.

Happy Valley Drive and Windebanks Road Junction

A new roundabout at the junction of Happy Valley Drive and Windebanks Road is proposed. The design includes separate left and right turn lanes on the Windebanks Road approach. The upgrade will include a pedestrian refuge on Windebanks Road for the Happy Valley Trail shared use path, new kerb and gutter, line marking, pavement construction and resurfacing, as well as new and upgraded lighting.

Walking and Cycling Safety

To improve safety for people using the Happy Valley Trail, a new pedestrian refuge is proposed on Windebanks Road. The upgrades are also proposed to include new and upgraded paths to improve access and connectivity in the area.


