Investigation works - Kangarilla Road

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region. The road improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety, and increase fire resilience.

The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening:

Investigation works are required on Kangarilla Road between Potter Road, Clarendon and McLaren Flat Road, Kangarilla. These investigations will support planning for potential upgrades along this road.

When

Monday 15 July 2024 to Friday 16 August 2024, weather permitting.

Hours of operation

Monday to Friday between the hours of 9am and 4pm

Where

Kangarilla Road between Potter Road, Clarendon and McLaren Flat Road, Kangarilla

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, there will be speed and lane restrictions on Kangarilla Road during work hours. Investigations and traffic restrictions will move progressively along Kangarilla Road.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage. Outside of work hours, Kangarilla Road will be fully open with no speed restriction in place.

Access to businesses and surrounding properties will be maintained throughout these works, and we will ensure every effort is made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties as practically possible.

Minor noise disturbances can be expected while works are ongoing, but we will minimise any disturbance to residents as much as practically possible.
