

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken adjacent the Gawler rail corridor in Dry Creek.

Location: Churchill Road North and Cormack Road, Dry Creek (see map overleaf).

When:

- 9pm Wednesday 27 February until 6am Thursday 28 February (weather permitting)

Activities:

- Removal of redundant power poles adjacent the Gawler line rail corridor
- Realignment of overhead power wires

Traffic management:

- Cormack Road and Churchill Road North will be under traffic management while these works are in progress. Speed and temporary lane restrictions may be required, and signage and traffic management will be in place to advise motorists of changed conditions.
- Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses.
