PROPOSED NAN HAI PU TUO TEMPLE AT SELLICKS HILL

Guidelines for a Development Report

On 28 December 2008 the Minister for Urban Development and Planning declared a proposal to establish a temple and associated facilities at Sellicks Hill, would be assessed using the major development provisions of the *Development Act* 1993 (declaration under Section 46(1)).

The DAC has determined that the Nan Hai Pu Tuo Temple of Australia Inc. must prepare a **Development Report** (DR) regarding the proposal and has issued formal Guidelines outlining the environmental, social and economic issues which the DR must address.
