Woodside Road and Princes Highway intersection, Nairne

The South Australian Government continues its commitment to improving road safety and traffic efficiency through the upgrade of the Woodside Road intersection with the Princes Highway at Nairne. The Princes Highway carries around 8,000 vehicles per day to the east of Woodside Road and 13,000 vehicles per day to the west of Woodside Road. Woodside Road carries approximately 7,000 vehicles per day.

Preliminary planning has identified road-realignment and roundabout as the preferred solution for the Nairne intersection upgrade to reduce delays for Woodside Road traffic and maintain a good level of intersection performance now and into the future. The upgrade will also aim to improve pedestrian and cyclist movements in the area and ensure safe access, particularly for Nairne Primary School students.

The proposed roundabout and road-realignment would, subject to feedback, involve land acquisition and potentially impacted residents and property owners will be contacted directly.

Onkaparinga Valley Road, Tiers Road and Nairne Road intersection, Woodside

The Australian Government has committed \$2 million within its Roads of Strategic Importance Initiative to upgrade the Woodside intersection. The upgrade will improve intersection safety and cater for future growth in the region.

The planning study to identify a preferred upgrade solution will commence in late 2019.
