

Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Portrush and Magill roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$98 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

While the majority of works are being undertaken during the day, night works are being undertaken to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Night works to place new asphalt and install new underground stormwater infrastructure, SA Water sewer and water mains, and traffic signal conduits are being undertaken at various locations on Magill Road west of the intersection, and Portrush Road north and south of the intersection.

Night works will continue from late July 2021, through to late September 2021, weather permitting.

Hours of work will be between 7pm and 6am, from Sunday to Thursday. No works will be undertaken on Friday and Saturday nights.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times, with speed and lane restrictions in place.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

The footpath and bike lane on the western side of Portrush Road will be closed between Beulah Road and Dover Street for approximately eight weeks, weather permitting. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours (see detour map). Cyclists continuing north can do so via Adelaide Street or by crossing at the traffic signals and travelling on the eastern side of Portrush Road. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Public transport services will not be affected during the works, however if required, advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au
