

# Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Asphalt weekend works – Stage 1

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, asphalt works are required to be undertaken within the new intersection. These works will be undertaken in stages, across a series of full weekends throughout the month of February 2023.

The first stage of works will be undertaken in the north-eastern quadrant of the intersection, from **7pm Friday, 3 February, both day and night until 6am Monday, 6 February 2023, weather permitting.**

### What to expect

To safety facilitate these works and manage traffic flows, speed and lane restrictions will be in place across the intersection with different traffic arrangements in place during night shifts and day shifts across the weekend. Please see details below:

The following traffic arrangements will be in place during **night shifts on Friday, 3 and Saturday 4, February between 7pm – 7am and Sunday, 5 February between 7pm and 6am:**

- Ringarooma Avenue will be closed at the junction with Fullarton Road. Local access will be via Clinton Avenue and Hexham Avenue or Cross Road and Hexham Avenue;
- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Hampstead Avenue; and
- right turns will not be permitted out of Euston Avenue.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Night works' for details of the above arrangements.

The following traffic arrangements will be in place **during day shifts on Saturday, 4 and Sunday, 5 February between 7am – 7pm:**

- Ringarooma Avenue will be closed at the junction with Fullarton Road. Local access will be via Clinton Avenue and Hexham Avenue or Cross Road and Hexham Avenue;
- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Hampstead Avenue; and
- right turns will not be permitted out of Euston Avenue.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Day works' for details of the above arrangements.

The pedestrian crossing on Fullarton Road, on the northern side of the intersection, will be closed during the works for safety reasons. Pedestrians will need to use the Cross Road crossings (east or west) to then access the pedestrian crossing on the southern side of Fullarton Road.

There is no change to public transport services.

## OFFICIAL

Access to Cross Road properties will be maintained during the works. There will be some short-term access impacts to properties on Fullarton Road in the work area, during night works. The project team will contact affected property owners and residents directly.

Traffic controllers will be on-site to assist pedestrians and signage will be in place. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

Emergency services vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

### Permanent access changes

As part of the upgraded intersection, right turn movements at Ringarooma Avenue, Euston Avenue and Hexham Avenue will be permanently removed. This will occur via the construction of a solid median on Fullarton Road and Cross Road adjacent these streets.

These changes will start to come into effect during the week commencing 13 February 2023.

The removal of these movements is required to provide improved traffic flow, efficiency and safety through the upgraded Cross Road/Fullarton Road intersection.


