Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Main Road, Cherry Gardens

As part of the State Government's election commitments, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering safety upgrade works on Main Road, Cherry Gardens. This project forms part of the \$150 million Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package, which includes a range of road improvements to support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience in the Adelaide Hills.

What to expect

Early works along Main Road, between Black Road and Chandlers Hill Road, including vegetation management, will commence from **Monday**, **6 November 2023**. These works are expected to be completed in early **December 2023**, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday and between 7am and 3pm on Saturdays. No works will be undertaken on Sundays.

To safely undertake these works, some short-term speed and lane restrictions will be in place, intermittently as required on Main Road during work hours. Traffic controllers will be onsite to manage the flow of traffic.

Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Local access to properties will be maintained throughout the work area, with advance notice provided to residents if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Major construction is scheduled to commence in early 2024 after the Tour Down Under event. Further information about the timing of construction works and the planned traffic management will be provided in advance. Project completion is expected in early 2025, weather permitting.
