Landscaping Fact Sheet


As part of the Mitcham Hills Corridor Upgrade the South Australian Government is upgrading the Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junctions. This upgrade will increase capacity across the road network and improve road safety for all users.

As part of the Project, new landscaping is being established, incorporating new plants within the project area.

The landscape plan and plant selection have been developed in consultation with the City of Mitcham and will include varieties such as:

- Bottlebrush Hakea (Hakea Francisiana) and
- Hakea Red Pokers (Hakea bucculenta).





The landscape design and plant selection complement the local biodiversity, assisted by careful selection of plants suitable to the area. Please see the plan over the page.

Landscaping works will continue until late-2024, weather permitting.
